Horizons project:

This year our curriculum will largely be delivered using IPADs. It is vital that they are fully charged to 100% every night. If you wish to find out any more information about the curriculum and Horizons, please see the link on our

Absence: Oasis Academy Aspinal's attendance target is 96.2 %. Just 3 days off over the year brings your child's attendance below the school's attendance target. Please call school by 9.00am if your child is ill and unable to attend – 0161 223 0053

School Meals: Meals are cooked daily on the premises and cost £2.30 per day/ £11.50 for the week. Please help us by paying for your meals in advance on Parent Pay. Pupils in arrears may be asked to make alternative arrangements. If you decide to change to packed lunches there is no longer a requirement to give us notice.

Packed Lunches: Please help us to maintain our Healthy School status by providing nutritious packed lunches. Sweets, chocolate bars and fizzy drinks are not permitted. Try to include at least one piece of fruit or vegetable and avoid fried, salty snacks such as crisps.

Holidays: Parents are requested NOT to take holidays during term time. Holidays during term time will be classed as unauthorised absences and will incur a fine.

Clothing: Pupils should wear their Oasis Academy uniform including black trousers or skirt, blue polo shirt and navy blue jumper or cardigan. They must wear suitable black footwear every day and items of jewellery are not allowed for health and safety reasons.

Water: We ask that every child brings a bottle of fresh drinking water every day as hydration is important and helps concentration. Fizzy or flavoured drinks are NOT permitted as they can contain additives and sugars that are harmful to dental health.

Birthdays: Children are permitted to give out individual, wrapped sweets at the end of the day. We will not allow children to eat them in school and they will be asked to check permission with an adult before eating them.

Class Champions: Across the school we have put in place a reward system for positive behaviour around school and in class. The children earn points for good behaviour on Class Dojo for following the school rules- parents may access this to see their own child's behaviour each week. In assembly on Friday, the child with the most points becomes the Class Champion and will be awarded with a certificate and will earn certain privileges such as sitting at a top table for lunch.

Medical: If your child requires medicine this must be obtained via prescription from a doctor in order for the school to administer- it must be clearly labelled

with your child's name and dosage. All inhalers must be kept in the classroom, any other medicine must go to the main office.

Class Information

Physical Education: Children need a white T-shirt and black shorts for Dance/Gymnastics. They will also need jogging bottoms and trainers for Outdoor Games (leggings are not permitted for gym). Children's PE kit should be named, in a clearly labelled bag. Our PE days are Tuesday and Friday.

Reading: Your child's reading record will be checked in class EVERY DAY. It must be a regular habit to read each night in practise. Books must be completed before changing unless your child is having particular difficulties with a book and they may take a quiz to check their understanding of the story and vocabulary- you can look out for their results in their reading records. The pass mark is 60%.

Homework: The children will be given homework on a Friday and it will be expected to be completed by the following Wednesday. There will be a homework club on Tuesday at lunchtime for children who have any particular difficulties. This is NOT a chance for children to complete homework but to have support with any particular areas they are struggling with. As we get towards SATs, they will be given extra homework including SATs papers to be completed over weekends ready to discuss in class the following week.

Booster Groups: Later this year, there will be selected groups of children taken for additional sessions for maths, reading and writing. You will be informed via a letter home. If your child is chosen for these, it is strongly advised that they attend every session for them to achieve their full potential!
