Where is Egypt?

- To identify the continents and which continent Egypt belongs to.
- I can find Egypt on a map.
 - I know which seas and countries surround Egypt.

Features of Egypt

- To know the geographical features of Egypt.
- I can describe what Egypt is like (hot/cold, wet/dry, small/big)
 - I know facts about Egypt's climate, population and location.

- I can use pictures to describe tourist attractions in Egypt.

 - Look at the appearance of some of the famous deities.

 - I can describe ways we can learn about ancient Egypt from the pyramids that have survived.

- To investigate inventions and achievements from the ancient Egyptians.
- I can describe some of the inventions of the ancient Egyptians.
 - I can evaluate some of the achievements of the ancient Egyptians and suggest how they are relevant to us today.
