IMPORTANT - Information in the event of a local lockdown or a class having to isolate

We are conscious children have been out of school for a long time. During lockdown we provided paper packs of work and teachers put timetables on each day and supported on Class Dojo. This may have been links to websites or tasks set on SumDog or Purple Mash.

All staff want to make sure we catch up any lost learning and should we have a class isolating for two weeks we want to continue with the education they would have received had they been in school.

Teachers are using PowerPoint in lessons for all subjects when teaching. In the event of an isolation or local lockdown these will be put onto Class Dojo at the start of each lesson. The teacher will record their voice over the PowerPoint as though they were live teaching. Children will be expected to follow the timetable for the school day as normal. They are expected to listen to the lessons at the same time they would have happened in school.

Children will then upload the work from that lesson into their Class Dojo portfolio so teachers can give feedback. ALL children are expected to do this. When we have advance notice of a local lockdown children will be provided with a blank exercise book to complete their work in to take a photo. Please make sure you have a Class Dojo login for all children you may have in school. The PowerPoints can be watched on phones/iPads and laptops. If you don't have internet to do this please contact Mr Foster on Class Dojo and we will look at ways to support you.
